<p>In Factor 1.7 the operatingsystemrelease fact for Solaris operating systems has been changed like so:</p> <pre>[root@solaris1:~]# factor -v 1.6.18 [root@solaris1:~]# factor operatingsystemrelease 5.10</pre> <p>Versus the newer Factor:</p> <pre>[root@solaris2:~]# factor -v 1.7.1 [root@solaris2:~]# factor operatingsystemrelease 10_u11</pre> <p>Foreman creates a new Solaris OS object for Solaris 1011 where \$major = 1011 and \$minor is blank. It would seem that the code to split the major/minor versions is ignoring the _u and smashing the numbers together into the major version.</p> <p>I haven't experimented as yet, but I imagine that this causes problems with provisioning as well.</p>
