<p>When ID's are reused in the DB, it is possible for audits to reattach themselves to newer objects with the same ID.</p> <p>for example:</p> <p>PuppetClass id 123 created, had audits referencing to the 123 id. later on, the class is deleted, but audits remain in the db.</p> <p>a year later, a new class is created, which reuse the 123 id. new audit is created, however, when asking for all audit revisions, we get back the original audits too.</p> <p>workaround, filter audit search based on timestamps, for example</p> <pre>p = Puppetclass.create :name =&gt; 'hello' p.audits.where("created_at &gt; ?", p.created_at)</pre>
