<p>/etc/yum.repos.d/foreman-plugins.repo from foreman-release-1.3.0-1.fc19.noarch ships with gpgcheck=1. But the files in the foreman-plugins repo are not actually signed.</p> <p>I see two solutions to this problem:</p> <p>1) Sign the packages, and leave the file as is</p> <p>2) Set gpgcheck=0 in the file.</p>
