<p>I've added an VMware "compute resources". It has an valid connection and I see all VMs in Foreman which are present in vcenter. /opt/rh/ruby193/root/usr/share/gems/gems/railties-3.2.8/lib/rails/generators/rails/app/templates/config/initializers/rbvmomi.rb

It's a VMware 5.5.

My linux machine is CentOS 6.4 updated this evening with yum update (Foreman 1.3.1 is installed to)
