| Description The Foreman code assumes the role is NOT NULL and tries to enforce it (https://github.com/theforeman/foreman/blob/b657d269a726e3bd3f7ebc8e67c7fc1d894d9176/app/models/filter.rb#L58) but it's not a database level constraint.
