<p>The Katello engine extends the Foreman User. As a result, if the Katello engine is included, it is not currently possible to successfully run 'rake db:migrate' to run all Foreman+Katello migrations.</p> <p>The primary issue exists with db/migrate/20100628123400_add_internal_auth.rb which attempts to create an initial User, but finds conflicts as the business logic is reliant on schema is not available until a later migration.</p> <p>This issue is to minimize the definition of User that is pulled in to the model to avoid this and possible future issues.</p>
