<b>Description</b> Scenario: - Setting S has default value D - With GUI or hammer, S is set to value V - Afterwards, S is set back to D  If you then run something like this to grab the settings: <code>while true; do date; hammer settings list   egrep 'ignore_ expire_soon_days puppet_out_of_sync_disabled login_text'; done</code>  it will return the value V from time to time instead of the value D (which was the last value set to S)  This happend with integer and default values.  I only found one workaround to remove 'before_save :clear_value_when_default' - then the default value is set to the settings table even if its the default value and everyting works as expected.
