<p>If no minor version is defined in the OS in Foreman, it is interpreted as 0.</p> <p>This is especially an issue, since Ubuntu >= 20.04.3 uses a different Installation Media path and templates.</p> <p>If the minor version is "nil" it should take the latest version (or no explicit .0 version).</p> <p>The issue is here: https://github.com/foreman/foreman/blob/6a292004b525e47acd946dd59fdc13af5bb21ba5/app/models/operatingsystems/debian.rb#L84</p>

If no minor version is defined, the function `minor.to_i` makes it a "0". Accordingly, Ubuntu 20.04 is interpreted as "no subiquity/Autoinstall" - but, if no minor version is given, Foreman should implicitly assume "latest" (which supports Autoinstall in fact).
