Description	
<p>Since fog-libvirt 0.12.0 the default CPU model was some abstract type with a low compatibility level. Since 0.12.0 it defaults to CPU passthrough, as recommended by qemu if live migration is not required (https://www.qemu.org/docs/master/system/qemu-cpu-models.html). That's not something we support today, so it should be safe to drop the CPU model selection.</p> <p>I can't determine if this was exposed in the API. At least not explicitly.</p>
