<p>There are currently only power states "on/off" on the host detail page (independently of the the actual compute resource).</p> <p>On the all host page you can select one or more hosts, click "Select Action" > "Change Power State" and choose from various power states like "start/stop/poweroff/reboot/reset/soft/cycle".</p> <p>This is quite inconsistent in my eyes, why not allow toggling all desired power states also on host detail page?</p> <p>Having this, libvirt VMs can then also be shut down consequently (=poweroff) if no OS is running (currently, power state "off" has no effect if no OS is running in VM).</p>
