If you navigate to **Monitor > Jobs** and click **Run Job**, the following text occurs on the **Schedule** step of the wizard:

Run job

Schedule

Select the type of execution

- Immediate execution
Execute the job now.
- Future execution
Execute the job later, at a scheduled time.
- Recurring execution
Execute the job on a repeating schedule.

Query type 

- Static query
evaluates just after you submit this form
- Dynamic query
evaluates just before the execution is started, so if it's planned in future, targeted hosts set may change before it

It looks like the text was never edited. The [documentation](#) is better but not ideal:

- Static query means that job executes on the exact list of hosts that you provided.

- Dynamic query means that the list of hosts is evaluated just before the job is executed. If you entered the list of hosts based on some filter, the results can be different from when you first used that filter.

I recommend updating the UI text so that it is grammatical.

Suggestions

Static query: Executes the job on the current list of target hosts.

Dynamic query: Evaluates the list of target hosts just before the job is executed. If you used a filter to select the target hosts, the list of target hosts might be different from the current list.
