<p>`katello-certs-check` and `foreman-installer --scenario katello` should support not using chain certificate file. Apache Httpd supports putting the chain in the same file as the leaf certificate. Supplying a chain file was even deprecated years ago.</p> <p>`foreman-installer --scenario katello --certs-server-cert "/etc/pki/tls/certs/my_cert.pem" --certs-server-key /etc/pki/tls/private/my_key.pem` will run `katello-certs-check`.</p> <p>`katello-certs-check` will complain about missing `-b CA_BUNDLE_FILE`.</p> <p><a href="https://httpd.apache.org/docs/current/mod/mod_ssl.html#sslcertificatefile">https://httpd.apache.org/docs/current/mod/mod_ssl.html#sslcertificatefile</a></p> <p>The files may also include intermediate CA certificates, sorted from leaf to root. This is supported with version 2.4.8 and later, and obsoletes SSLCertificateChainFile.
