<p>The error is ``No route matches {:action=>"login", :controller=>"users"}```</p> <p>On the other hand, going to ``/`` redirects to the login page without a problem.</p> <p>Once logged-in, ``/katello`` does not error.</p> <p>This [error happens on the engine branch](https://github.com/Katello/katello/tree/engine)</p> <p>In ``katello.yml`` I recently set ``use_ssl=false`` related to a different failing redirect, but this is most likely unrelated to any such change. I suspect it has something to do with the engine being isolated from the routes of the host application.</p> <p>Additionally, [I filed this in Bugzilla](https://bugzilla.redhat.com/show_bug.cgi?id=1032226) with just a link back here.
