### Description

While attempting to reset admin's password on my environment I observed the following:

Submitting the password reset form, with User: admin e-mail: root@localhost, generates a 302 redirecting the /katello/user\_session (which in turn is a 200 response).

Querying the DB (as I do not have e-mail configured) with:

katelloschema=# select password\_reset\_token from users where username='admin';

returns the value '64b9f799dc89264da7391685f38de6567480f6279d0b5b6ad9e0dac95e2828d7'.

### Browsing to

https://172.31.21.75/katello/password\_resets/64b9f799dc89264da7391685f38de6567480f6279d0b5b6ad9e0dac95e2828d7/edit generates a 302 Moved response to /katello/user\_session/new with not response data, just a redirection.

This observation is with Fedora 18, I have not tested with RHEL 6, but jsherrill appears to have reproduced this issue as well.
