<p>It would appear that katello-configure is somehow ignoring '--user-pass=' options and defaulting to the password of 'admin'.</p> <p>An example is running <code># katello-configure --user-pass=katello</code></p> <p>Attempting to go to https://localhost/katello/ after installation and logging in with admin/katello fails - without visual indication, but Firefox/Chrome developer consoles show that /katello/user_session returns 401 'Invalid credentials'.</p> <p>Based on my testing, and jsherrill's testing on IRC, it'd appear this is isolated to Fedora 18 as we aren't seeing this on RHEL6.</p> <p>An observation is that rerunning katello-configure with --reset-data=YES and --user-pass=katello, is generated a new encrypted password each time, but it appears to be encrypting 'admin' rather than 'katello'.</p> <p><i>Created: nigeljonez on May 15, 2013 02:55 +00:00</i> <i>Imported from https://api.github.com/repos/Katello/katello/issues/2287</i></p>
