## Description

Sosreport (package sos) in RHEL 6.5 contains "foreman" plugin that calls foreman-debug to collect foreman-related information. In Foreman 1.4 we added interactivity (if interactive console is found). It can be disabled with -q flag, but sosreport from RHEL 6.5 does not do that which leads to hang.

sosreport -o foreman --batch
