Description

The upgrade process was very smooth for 1.3.2 -> 1.4.0, but I was thinking it would be nice if it was even easier.

Red Hat Satellite takes the approach of an "rhn-upgrade" package. So when 1.5 rolls around, for example, you would publish foreman-upgrade into the 1.4 yum repo. Upgrade procedure would be something like:

- 1. yum install foreman-upgrade
- 2. foreman-upgrade

Which would switch to the 1.5 repo, run any rake tasks, and restart passenger.
