In the settings UI of the foreman web interface large values squash the UI and cause layout problems.	
Using the example of "root_pass" setting the value to a sha 512 hash of "redhat":	
\$6\$dt1FTGZ73aYvbWlu\$DJL61PaJ2mXbQGI77HXwHzvfNqPQLR66I4mG1IUg01H2A53OYd0EuL6DWzts59bMRdJilxT1fE2J7bANGzYo7/	
Causes the interface to expand the size of the entire "value" column needlessly.
