We are using Foreman on following version from Debian repos: Version : 1.3.1-1	
When a new host arrives on network and ask for provisioning, his first DHCP request is handled by DHCPd but the second one is not.	
It doesn't occurs on every run but it's not related to any kind of hardware.	
It occurs on 10 to 20% of provisioning.
