<b>Description</b>	
<p>It appears that IPAPPEND 2 is required when using ksdevice=bootif.</p> <p>I recently installed two HP Proliant DL380e Servers with an integrated 4 port NIC having only port 1 wired. According to various documentation, Fedora, CentOS, RedHat this is required to allow the PXE'd NIC to be passed to the loaded installer kernel to avoid the network interface selection prompt.</p> <p>The PXE Linux Template should look something like:</p> <pre>default linux label linux kernel boot/&lt;whatever&gt;-vmlinuz ipappend 2 append initrd=boot/&lt;whatever&gt;-initrd.img ks=http://foreman.example.com:80/unattended/provision ksdevice=bootif network kssendmac</pre>
