When running 'foreman-rake katello:reset' against the nightlies, various errors occur. For example: sudo: sorry, you must have a tty to run sudo (even with sudo password for wheel disabled and the foreman user in wheel)	
Couldn't drop foreman : #<ActiveRecord::StatementInvalid: PGError: ERROR: database "foreman" is being accessed by other users (even with httpd stopped)	
Expected /opt/rh/ruby193/root/usr/share/gems/gems/katello-1.5.0/app/models/katello/erratum_rule.rb to define Katello::ErratumRule
