The new content view workflow is much improved, however there is a slight problem in that the origin repository for puppet modules is not indicated.

If we are going to offer the ability to create multiple products/repos for puppet modules, then we should provide some mechanism to find them via that categorization in the view area.

For example, add a (Sortable/Filterable) column to the "add module" page that displays the origin product/repo of the module. Also, add the same column to the module list page for the view.

The alternative is to entirely re-vamp the way puppet modules are treated from a product/repo perspective. I would think adding some columns to the pages might be easier.
