<p>Since #4658, the smart proxy on Debian 7 can't load the ruby-augeas gem.</p> <p>We were relying on it being present because the puppet package was installed, however the proxy package (deliberately) doesn't carry dependencies on puppet or augeas.</p> <p>What's happening though is that the puppet package is built for Ruby 1.8 only, with explicit dependencies on ruby1.8 and libaugeas-ruby1.8, while the smart proxy uses the default Ruby 1.9 so can't load libaugeas-ruby.</p>

The problem on Debian/wheezy is, that foreman-proxy is running under Ruby 1.9 (system default), but puppet is on version 2.7.x, which has no support for ruby >1.8, so the dependency on puppet does pull in only libaugeas-ruby1.8.
