<div><div>Description</div><div>Scenario:<div>1. go to a page that uses the 2-pane style UI (e.g. Operating Systems)</div><div>2. open an object on that page (e.g. click an OS)</div><div>3. observe that the browser URL does not reflect the object that is opened</div></div><div><div>This can be problematic for multiple reasons, such as:</div><div><div>- user cannot copy/paste the URL to share with others</div><div>- user cannot bookmark the page using the browser</div><div>- the UI cannot cross-link objects between pages</div></div><div><div>The first and last are the more important issues.</div></div></div></div>
