Can you check that puppetca\_use\_sudo is enabled in settings.yml? This is required so the proxy can launch puppet as root and change the

system-wide CA, it looks from your log that it's trying to execute as foreman-proxy only.

I am using sudo:

```
1. enable PuppetCA management
:puppetca: true
:ssldir: /var/lib/puppet/ssl
:puppetdir: /etc/puppet
:puppetca_use_sudo: true
:sudo_command: /usr/bin/sudo
```
