The new "location_fact" setting to automatically update a hosts location to the therein configured fact does not get evaluated.			
It always and only looks for a fact named "location_fact", not for "foreman_location", which is the in-page default in the admin settings page, nor any other configured custom fact.			
The issue seems to be this, as was pointed out in IRC today by either "Dominic" or "acidrainfall": http://projects.theforeman.org/projects/foreman/repository/revisions/e88536b278c403ae2e0e34f0e0e2de457bf95383/entry/app/models/host/base.rb#L112
