### UI should raise validation error when host-collection limit exceeds for adding content-hosts

Description of problem: Created a host collection with limit 2 and later added two content-hosts successfully. But When I tried to add another host in same collection, nothing happens on UI. UI neither generates any error not updating the host-collection with another entry which it shouldn't.
