2. add rule to filter	
content definition filter add_rule --org org --definition def --name filter --content "rpm" --rule '{"units": [{"min_version": "2.5.0", "max_version": "4.2.0"}]}'

Fixes #6050 - Better error message on filter rules create

Basically cli did this on filter rule create with no filter rule params specified.

```
$ hammer content-view filter rule create --content-view-id=4
--organization-id=1 --content-view-filter-id 1
```

Could not create the filter rule:  
Error: 400 Bad Request

This commit fixes that by giving more context on what needs to be specified. This is slightly tricky because depending on errata or package filters the "base" field requirement is bound to change. Here are the 2 scenarios this fix now handles..

1) On a package filter specifying package rule it raises name cant be blank.

```
$ hammer content-view filter rule create --content-view-id=4  
--organization-id=1 --content-view-filter-id 1
```

Could not create the filter rule:  
Validation failed: Name can't be blank

2) On an erratum filter specifying erratum rule it raises something else

```
$ hammer content-view filter rule create --content-view-id=4  
--organization-id=1 --content-view-filter-id 2
```

Could not create the filter rule:  
Validation failed: Invalid erratum filter rule specified, Must specify at least one of the following: 'errata\_id', 'start\_date', 'end\_date' or 'types'
