Description of problem: When a user has more than one capsule installed (say, default server + external capsule) and tries to import, the "import" button becomes a dropdown to choose which to import from. hostnames in this dropdown are obscured by border of browser however, and no resizing fixes it.

How reproducible:	
Steps to Reproduce: 1. Create/register an external capsule. Might want to make sure the hosts have reasonably long hostnames 2. Configuration > Puppet Classes 3. Click the import button	
Actual results: Hostnames get obscured off the side of the browser window. cannot resize to see complete hostnames.	
Expected results: hostnames are fully readable.
