<p>I've installed a VM via foreman successfully but it was not marked as built. The cause seems to be a mixture of #5883 (token timeout/mismatch) and the additional complexity of my setup: the VM is behind a NAT, which supplies the http request with the IP address of an already built (but totally unrelated) system. Therefore UnattendedController#<code>get_host_details</code> matches on the NAT host (via UnattendedController#<code>find_host_by_ip_or_mac</code>), but immediately fails on the <code>@host.build</code> check in UnattendedController#<code>allowed_to_install?</code>.</p> <p>It'd be great if the UnattendedController could just reject all requests with an invalid token, putting a specific error message into the log?</p>
