1. Create an activation key 'AK1' (this creates an internal label AK1)
2. Update name 'AK1' to 'AK2'
3. Attempt to create an activation key 'AK1' again

#### Actual results:

UI does not do anything - neither creates activation key nor throws user error. But I can see the error in production.log
