<p>When doing several equal posts to https://&lt;host&gt;/api/v2/hostgroups/&lt;hostgroupname&gt;/parameters with a json of { "parameter" : { "name" : "foo", "value" : "something" } }, I am able to create several parameters named "foo".</p> <p>When manipulating the same parameters with put on https://&lt;host&gt;/api/v2/hostgroups/&lt;hostgroupname&gt;/parameters/&lt;internal id of param&gt; with the json of { "parameter" : { "value" : "something" } }, an error stating</p> <pre>{ "error": { "id":3528,"errors":{"name":["has already been taken"]},"full_messages":["Name has already been taken"]} }</pre> <p>is returned. I feel that this error should also be returned on the second POST above in the interests of providing a clear and orthogonal API.</p>
