Description A tiny plugin that would allow to "tail" various log files from the system. List of allowed files would be configured as well as number of last lines returned. In the Foreman UI, this would be sub-menu or button in the list of Smart Proxies, or on a detail page. By default it would only return foreman-proxy log, latest 500 lines. For foreman discovery image purposes, the plugin would be installed and configured to return all possible logs (beware the kernel command line which can contain root password). This way, users should be able to view logs from nodes.
