If I consider my Subnet configuration:

Network 192.168.1.0 Mask 255.255.255.0

Ranges 192.168.1.130-192.168.1.20

DHCP and TFTP Proxy Defined

When a I create a new host, I choose my proxy, my domain and my subnet but foreman keep proposing me an ip out of the range of my defined subnet.

eg: 192.168.1.2 (in fact the first free ip in the network's subnet (Network/Mask without considering imposed range).

If I manualy choose IP (in or out of the range) everything else works just fine.
