By default when determining the resource_type to be used for a model authorization, the name of the model class is used. This behaviour is hard to change from within a plugin, as the logic is included in just one method https://github.com/theforeman/foreman/blob/1.7.1/app/services/authorizer.rb#L115-L127.

My case is the foreman-tasks (<u>http://projects.theforeman.org/issues/4450/</u>) where there is an STI on the task model, so the default name would be `dynflow_task`, while the desired name is just `task`.
