<b>Description</b> Currently associating a vm with a host fails for all compute resources but for Ovirt. The reason is that to do the association we make a query based on the ip or mac attributes of the Host, which are now in its own model. <pre>...Host.authorized(:view_hosts, Host).where(:ip...</pre> Fix should be as simple as performing the 'where' on the interfaces instead of the host and a couple of tests ensuring this won't break again.
