LDAP settings are configured, but user cannot login.

Suggestions for improvement:

This is more a request than a bug, but there needs to be a "Test LDAP Connection" button with a viewable error message. Nowadays almost all enterprise products have this feature. Having to debug user login errors without being able to first confirm your LDAP settings even work creates a hassle when troubleshooting.
