When you click any of these, it will open up two tabs for each one you click. If I click on the Blog link, I get two tabs for that, if I click on the redhat_access plugin link, I get two "this server could not be found" tabs (I don't know what http://www.lphiri.redhat.com/ is supposed to be, but it doesn't appear to be working, whatever it is), etc. We should only open a single tab for a clicked link, and we should figure out if http://www.lphiri.redhat.com/ is where the redhat_access plugin should be trying to link to.
