<div>Description</div> <div>As per github.com/chupman request:</div> <div>I was hoping to add the option of enabling login support via the mail field in addition to the login_attr field. To do this without hard coding the attribute the config class would need to also expose the mail field from the foreman ldap configuration.</div> <div>Use Case:</div> <div>If a directory service uses serial numbers for employee uid and groupOfUniqueNames mappings, but users use an email for logins I believe it is current impossible to configure ldap with both group support and the ability to login with the user preferred attribute.</div>
